THE 1ST SUNDAY IN LENT

Today is the **THE 1ST SUNDAY IN LENT**, the 40-day period of preparation before **EASTER**, April 16th. During Lent, Pastor Haley's sermons will focus on some of our favorite encounters of Jesus, as follows:

- Today - Jesus in the Wilderness (Matthew 4: 1 - 11)
- March 12 - Jesus and Nicodemus (John 3: 1 - 17)
- March 19 - Jesus and the Woman at the Well (John 4: 5 - 42)
- March 26 - Jesus and the Man Born Blind (John 9: 1 - 41)
- April 2 - Jesus and the Raising of Lazarus (John 11: 1 - 45)
- April 9 - Palm/Passion Sunday (entrance to Holy Week)
- April 13 - Maundy Thursday Service
- April 14 - Good Friday Stations of the Cross
- April 16 - **EASTER**

What is Lent?

Lent is an important season in the Church's year. Every year Christians use Lent to prepare themselves for the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, on Easter Sunday.

When is Lent?

Lent is the forty days before Easter. Christians do not include Sundays in the forty days because they celebrate Jesus' resurrection every Sunday. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday.
