- **WELCOME!** If you are a guest tonight, we welcome you, and are honored that you have come to worship at Central on this special night.
- **RESTROOMS** are downstairs. There is also an accessible restroom just outside the sanctuary, to the left.
- During the 6 pm service, all children present are invited to the front for the **CHILDREN'S MESSAGE**.

- The **ALTAR POINSETTIAS** are given by the people of the congregation in celebration of the birth of the Christ Child. (*See the enclosed list.*) The white **ALTAR CLOTH**, given by **MAE WILLIAMS**, is from Poland. The blue **ALTAR CLOTH**, given by **PASTOR DAVID & MICHELE**, was bought from a Palestinian cloth merchant in the Old City of Jerusalem.
